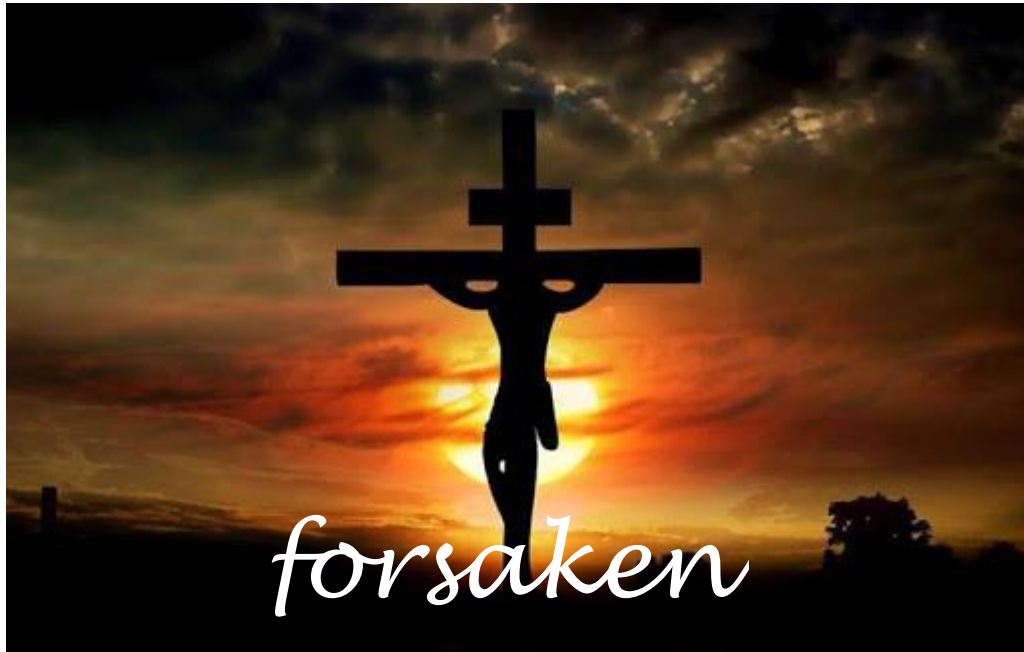


Title – Wrath and Mercy at the Cross
